Our client on this project desired a building which would reflect the nature of his business and that would appeal to his clients (Paul McCartney, Peter Gabriel, Stereophonics and many famous rock groups) who go to view their computerised stage lighting designs before going on tour.

The three storey offices at the front of the building have a two storey high wall of cast structural glass which allows light to flood the offices/atrium and showcase areas. The glazed walls and atrium roof also allow the fixed display of stage lighting at the top of the atrium to shine out from the building. The design incorporates state of the art light testing facilities and the highest warehouse space in Park Royal.
